This is in response to your letter dated July 16, 1999, forwarding the referenced reports to this office. The first report documents additional work performed in areas that were indicated to contain soil with greater than two percent total petroleum hydrocarbons. The closure report summarizes all work performed at the site from 1994 to the present.

Based on the information provided to this office, I agree that no further action appears to be necessary with the understanding that the future use of the property will be restricted. However, the original crude oil storage tanks were not moved during characterization or remedial work. Therefore, if evidence of pollution is discovered from contamination underneath these tanks or other areas at this site, additional steps may be necessary.
